Building and Grounds Meeting called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Sandra Clutter

- Several issues were discussed by Mr. Orr and Mr. Snoke on Student High School Parking
 - Total Parking Spaces = 312
 - 116 Seniors issued parking passes
 - 34 Juniors issued parking passes
 - 143 Staff Members assigned parking places
 - 12 more available = 8 set aside for food service and 4 general adult spaces
 - 7 additional spaces clear of the building
 - Total parking spaces at the High School = 312
 - Spaces have not been issued to Sophomores or Freshman
 - Student Parking Tag cost is \$30.00 per year
 - Procedures are followed for issuance of tags check license- sports affiliation special events – tutorial needs - discipline
 - FYI The high school has 30 mores spaces on campus than 2010-11 school year
 - Parking "pit" closing was a safety issue
 - Would it be feasible to open the pit for fall and spring
 - Question on Range Resource funding to add sidewalks and lighting Mrs. Clutter advised since this was such a safety issue with security etc. Range Resource gave permission to re-assign the funding

 Notification was received that the cheerleaders need padding on the "TRACK" surface of the football field - Mrs. Clutter and Mr. Kuzman stated the surface they use is not concrete
