High School Highlights

- From 2016-2019, Trinity saw a 347% increase in qualifying AP Scores in math, science and English. Increasing from 51 AP MSE qualifying scores in 2016 to 228 in 2019!
 - Although the Keystone Score pass rate was not as high as last year, the current seniors surpassed the states prediction for our student achievement in algebra and biology (see next slide).

Trinity North Academic Achievement

- All Trinity North teachers were rated green or better on the 2018-19 PVAAS, indicating that a majority of students met academic growth standards in Grades 3-5 Math/ELA and Grade 4 Science.
- Trinity North was #1 in TASD for student growth in math.
- Both 4th grade math teacher Alexa Seelye and 5th grade math teacher Ashley Szala earned the state's highest rating for student growth, placing them each in the top 600 teachers in PA in their grade levels!
- Trinity North Grade 5 earned third highest scores in Washington County.

Trinity West Academic Achievement

- Trinity West 5th grade teachers were rated light blue or blue in PVAAS indicating that their students exceeded the academic growth standards in ELA and Math.
- Trinity West 4th grade teachers were rated green indicating their students met the growth standard in ELA and blue in Science meaning they exceeded the growth standard.
- West teachers are utilizing flexible grouping, school tutoring, PVASS, CDT's and IXL to personalize instruction for their students. Big academic gains are expected in 2020.

Trinity South Academic Achievement

- Trinity South's SPP Score was 79.0% which was the second highest score in the district (3 12).
- Trinity South students achieved the highest scores in 4 out of 7 PSSA assessments reported in the district's four elementary schools (Grades 3-5).
- Trinity South's 4th grade students achieved 98.0% advanced/proficient on the PSSA Science assessment which was the highest score in the county.
- South's 3rd grade students achieved 76% advanced/proficient on the PSSA Math which was the highest in the district and 8th in the county. Ranked #1 in Washington County.
- South's 5th grade students achieved the 4th highest scores on the PSSA Math assessment in the county.
