Trinity High School students continue to outperform other students in the region. According to the Pennsylvania Department of Education's 2016-2017 School Performance Profile, Trinity Area High School earned the highest score among high schools in Washington County. The achievement calculations were based on the academic performance of our current seniors (class of 2018) and the educational programs and opportunities offered to our high school students.

In addition Trinity made a 188% gain in students passing AP exams. The National Mathematics and Science Initiative (NMSI) rated Trinity High School number one in the nation for AP participation and score improvement.
