The meeting was called to order at 4:30 p.m. by the chairman, Scott Day.

The committee recommended authorization of payment to GG&C in the sum of \$1,832.38 for additional balances due with the stipulation that the amount be donated back to the Trinity band.

The opt-out incentive was discussed, there will be no changes.

The committee recommended that the solicitor join a law suit in Allegheny County regarding Central Tax Bureau. The committee also recommended that the solicitor contact Washington Ballpark association to discuss the agreement between the association and the district. It was also the recommendation of the committee that Mr. Makel look into appealing assessments for Lakeview Estates.

Mr. Shargots indicated that the auditor will be in the district in the next few weeks and that he will review updated budget reports for the previous year and the current year after that time.

The committee recommended a RFP be done for bus contracts.

The purchase of school vans was discussed.

Training for aides on vans/busses was discussed. It was suggested that Mrs. King may be able to provide the training.

The committee requested a list of bus drivers from the contractors.

Dr. Kasunich reported that Edulog will be implemented at the remaining elementary buildings (North, South and West) and the Middle School.
