MINUTES

1. Fall Sports Update – Tryouts began on Monday, Volleyball ~24, Football ~50, Girls Soccer ~29, Boys Soccer ~25, Tennis ~, Boys XC ~15, Girls XC ~12, Golf ~16
2. Football Season Tickets – Season Tickets are on sale for the Football Season, Season Tickets are sold for Reserved Seating at a cost of \$24 for the 4 home games. All tickets sold on Friday nights will be general admission. Letters have been sent out to all football, cheer and band parents, along with current season ticket holders. Custom Season Ticket Sheets have been printed for ticket holders, we were able to save \$340 on the cost of the tickets and they look great.
3. Event Ticket Pricing – Ticket pricing for athletic event for the 2015-16 school year will be as follows: Varsity Football, Basketball, Wrestling - \$5 Adults, \$3 Students: All other Sports \$4 Adults, \$2
4. School Spirit Plans/Fall Season Kickoff Assembly, Homecoming Plans – We handed out T-shirts at Freshman Orientation, also had Varsity Cheerleaders on hand to greet students and give building tours. 1st Pep Assembly of year will be Fri Sept 4th in HS Gym. We will recognize all of our fall sports teams and their seniors. Homecoming Football will be Fri Oct 9th vs Uniontown. The parade will be held at 6:30pm on Thurs Oct 8th, going from Trinity West to the Middle School/Stadium, where we will have the rally and bon fire. We are encouraging participation from all of our schools, sports teams and community organizations. Friday will be the Pep Assembly and football game.
5. NCAA Recruiting Info Night – Oct 1st HS Auditorium 6:30pm for parents and students in grades 7-12. Mr. Rich will present information, along with guest speaker, Darnell Dinkins and our THS Guidance Dept.
6. Athletic Program Health Metric – Throughout the year we will compile an Athletic Program Health Metric to review our varsity programs in the areas of Performance, Participation, GPA, Succession and Multi-sport participation. The metric will score on a scale of 1-3 pts in each category and the categories are averaged for an overall score. The info is compiled each year and will reflect the 3 year trend of growth each program. The categories that are reviewed have documented data, removing opinions and bias.
7. Stadium Concession Arrangements – Mr. Chambers through Football Boosters, expressed concerns over lack of help in running the concession stand at Football games. Asked for Boosters to completely take over the concessions instead of sharing revenue with Band. Mr. Rich will speak with our band leaders and organize a meeting to discuss what arrangements can be made to benefit all groups.
8. South Strabane Township Agreement – Mr. Rich updated the committee on the current standing with South Strabane Township on the use of the park facility. The district will continue to use the facility as a secondary option for our spring sports teams, but will ask the township to agree to letting T ASD

use the facility for whatever purposes they see fit, not exclusively Varsity Softball. Mr. Rich was also checking with Mr. Scott on district costs to run the facility as it stands now.
